Each issue of the Vital Times begins with a blank canvas, but it doesn't stay that way for long! Our outstanding farmers, their girls, and our crew give us plenty of noteworthy

stories to share. And like any newspaper, we have an editor-in-chief who is, in fact, the original founder of Vital Farms (Hi. Matt!).

Once an issue is published, it travels to Egg Central Station, where we pack our eggs. There, our tiny chicken newspaper is slipped into your carton and tucked away until you crack it open for your morning read. Once you're done enjoying the issue – don't throw it out! These little guys are fully compostable.
